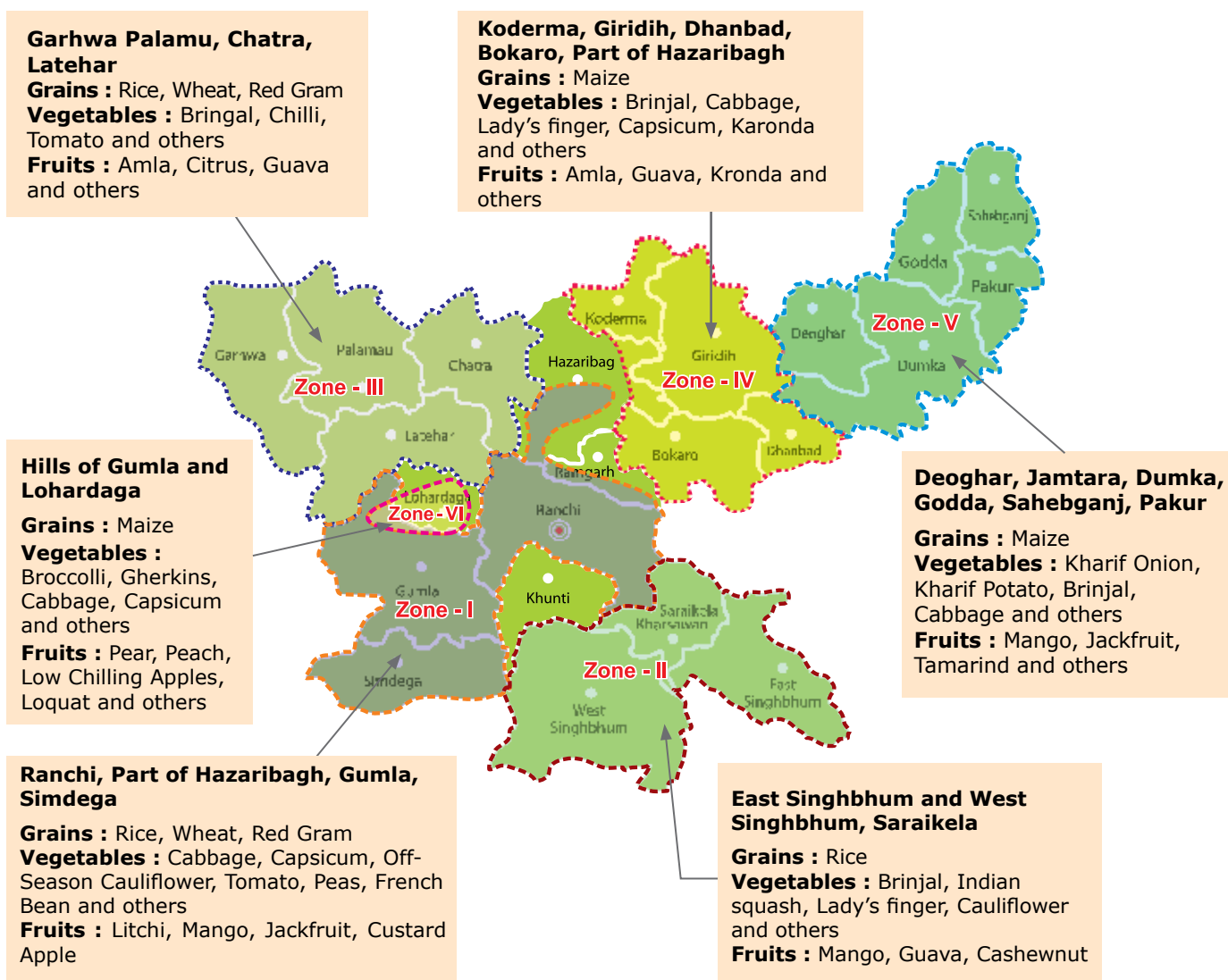

The State of Jharkhand was brought into existence on 15<sup>th</sup> November 2000 after carving 79.70 lakh hectares geographical area from the State of Bihar for better planning and execution of development activities of a ecologically different zone (Hills & Plateau region compared to Bihar plains). Jharkhand state is endowed with vast and rich natural resources mainly those of minerals, forest & rich agro climatic zones suitable for horticulture, fisheries, dairy, and forest produce.
